- Full day excursion to the outback town of Marree at the junction of the rugged Oodnadatta Track and the infamous Birdsville Track (weather permitting).
- Explore the old ghost town of Farina.
- Return to Adelaide via the country towns of Melrose and Clare.
- Visit the Wirrabara Craft House for quality hand-made crafts and view the amazing Silo Art.
- Optional: 30 minute scenic flight over Wilpena Pound (additional cost).
- *Optional*: 1.5hr scenic flight over the Marree Man and Lake Eyre South (additional cost).

# **ROAD CONDITIONS:**

This is an outback tour and should any destination or venue not be accessible due to weather and/or road conditions, the coach crew will advise the group accordingly and **the Coach Crew's decision is final**. Road conditions can change overnight and this is not a reason for cancellation of the tour. Any such event is a force of nature and beyond the control of Spark Travel. An alternative destination/venue will be inserted in lieu if practicable.

\*\*Health and Fitness: To assist us when booking, please advise your Spark Travel consultant if you have any special needs such as mobility, dietary etc.

This tour is not suitable for those with mobility issues and a minimum level of fitness is required in order to be able to participate. You will need to able to walk up a flight of stairs and manage coach steps unaided and you must inform us before the commencement of the tour of any medical condition which may affect your ability to participate in the tour. If you are unable to manage on your own, it will be necessary to be accompanied by another person who is fit and able to assist you in day to day tasks and capable of providing the assistance required. Dietary requests must be accompanied by the appropriate dietary information in writing.

# ABOUT YOUR ACCOMMODATION:

Accommodation throughout is good quality motel style and extremely comfortable. All rooms have private facilities, TV, clock/radio, airconditioning and heating, tea/coffee making facilities and refrigerator. Other facilities include dining room, lounge bar and TAB.

At Hawker all rooms are ground floor, at the Leigh Creek Outback Resort a few of the rooms have stairs up to the dining area - please advise your Spark Travel Consultant if you wish to be on dining level. (subject to availability).

# HUGHES TRANSFERS TO AND FROM YOUR HOME:

Hughes transfers apply in the zoned area. These transfers may be available at additional cost to passengers who live outside the zoned area - please ask your Spark Travel consultant. 'HUGHES HOME PICK UP SERVICE' will call you two (2) days before the commencement of the tour to confirm the time they will be arriving at your home. If you have missed the call, please contact Spark Travel (08) 8876 5121 a day prior to departure for your pickup time. If you reside at a retirement village, please ensure Hughes have clear instructions from you as to means of entry and directions to find your home. Also, if you are out of zone there will be an additional payment due and this should be made at the time of booking. For safety reasons, suitcases should weigh no more than 20kgs. The Hughes home pick up service only applies to scheduled tour departure and return tour dates. Those passengers wishing to extend their tours will be responsible for their own transfers.

### **ITINERARY:**

# DAY 01 - ADELAIDE/HAWKER - PICHI RICHI TRAIN, KANYAKA RUINS, JEFF MORGAN GALLERY

The tour departs from Adelaide Central Bus Station, 85 Franklin Street at 6.00am. Travel to Port Wakefield for a morning tea stop (own cost), then on through Crystal Brook to Port Augusta. At 10.30am, we join the 'Afghan Express' steam train to Quorn. Enjoy a superb ride back in time via the Pichi Richi Pass, and across the Willochra Plain with views of Devil's Peak. On arrival at Quorn enjoy a light lunch at the Trans Continental Hotel, established in 1878 and the oldest hotel in Quorn. Stop at the fascinating Kanyaka Ruins, carefully preserved by the National Trust, then onto our overnight stop at Hawker. Here we will view the amazing Wilpena Panorama – a 30 metre continuous landscape of pure grandeur, superbly painted by local artist Jeff Morgan, with special background sound effects of the Flinders Ranges provided by Bruce Emsley. Be captivated by the 360° birds' eye view of the spectacular Flinders Ranges as seen from St Mary's Peak. Check out the superb range of Jeff's paintings and prints, also lovingly handcrafted wares, including local hand-turned woodwork, pottery, scarves, jewellery, and soft toys.

OVERNIGHT: HAWKER HOTEL/MOTEL, HAWKER. (L,D)

Note: 12 October departure: Pichi Richi Railway train may be a diesel engine, depending on the fire risk at the time of travel.

# DAY 02 - HAWKER/LEIGH CREEK - WILPENA POUND, GORGES - OPTIONAL: WILPENA POUND SCENIC FLIGHT

This morning, take the **Moralana Scenic Route** through the heart of the magnificent Flinders Ranges, to **Wilpena**. There is an opportunity (subject to suitable weather conditions) to take an **optional 30 minute scenic flight over Wilpena Pound** (additional cost), or maybe just enjoy a stroll around the area. It is a good idea to take your camera, as there is **abundant wildlife** - kangaroos, emus, possums, the endangered yellow footed rock wallaby and wedge tailed eagles. A **light lunch** is included today in **Poddy Dodger's Bar** after which we depart Wilpena, with our route taking us to the **Cazenaux Tree**, a must for photographers, and past the Great Wall of China to **Blinman**. Our journey continues through beautiful **Parachilna Gorge**, location for **afternoon tea**.

We end our day at Leigh Creek in the Northern Flinders Ranges, our home for the next 2 nights. OVERNIGHT: LEIGH CREEK OUTBACK RESORT. (B,L,A,D)

# DAY 03 – AT LEIGH CREEK – MARREE, FARINA – *OPTIONAL*: MARREE MAN & LAKE EYRE SCENIC FLIGHT

This morning, we follow the Old Ghan railway line north to the tiny outback town of Marree, at the junction of the rugged Oodanatta Track and the infamous Birdsville Track. Marree (aboriginal name for possum), was the staging post for camel trains which were the main means of transporting supplies and heavy loads in the Outback. An *optional 1.5 hour scenic flight* is available out of Marree over the iconic and mysterious 2.4km long Marree Man at Callanna, then out over Lake Eyre South to view the amazing scenery (additional cost). Those passengers not flying will enjoy morning tea off the coach and take a drive along part of the Oodnadatta Track (conditions permitting), then everyone will enjoy a BBQ lunch at the historic Marree Hotel also home to the famous outback mailman Tom Kruse Collection. On our return journey to Leigh Creek, we take time to explore the ruins of the old ghost town of Farina. OVERNIGHT: LEIGH CREEK OUTBACK RESORT. (B,M,L,D)

### DAY 04 - LEIGH CREEK/ADELAIDE - WIRRABARA CRAFT HOUSE AND SILO ART

This morning, we regretfully say farewell to our hosts at Leigh Creek and rejoin our coach for the return journey to Adelaide. Pass the Mount Remarkable National Park and onto Melrose, one of the oldest towns in the lower Flinders Ranges, where we will enjoy a 'pub lunch' at the Mt Remarkable Hotel. Our route then takes us onto the immaculately maintained little town of **Wirrabara**. Here we will visit the **Wirrabara Craft House** for an opportunity to purchase some superb local crafts and view the amazing 28m **Wirrabara Silo Art**, painted by renowned Australian artist Sam Bates, known as 'Smug' Later, continue via the old town of Gladstone, famous for the historic gaol, and the lovely Clare Valley, arriving back at **Adelaide Central Bus Station** at approximately **7.00pm**. **(B,L)**

#### FUEL SURCHARGES AND TAXES:

All bookings may attract additional fuel surcharges and taxes which can be levied up to and including the date of departure even if final payment has been made. Booking is subject to final audit.

#### SECURITY DEPOSIT:

A non-refundable security deposit of \$675.00 per person (inc GST) is required within five (5 days) of booking.

#### FINAL PAYMENTS:

The security deposit forms part of the total price, the balance of which is due 60 days prior to departure, or in the case of bookings made within that 60 day period, the final payment is due as soon as the booking is confirmed.

#### LATE BOOKINGS AND AMENDMENTS:

Bookings made within 7 days inclusive of departure will incur a **late booking fee of \$75.00 per person**. Late bookings subject to availability. Once a booking has been made a **\$75.00 per person amendment fee** will apply for any alterations on selected departures only, and if applicable, one (1) change only to that booking. Transfers to other tours not permitted.

#### CREDIT CARDS:

If paying by credit card, a surcharge applies of 2% for Visa and Mastercard and 3.5% for Amex and Diners cards.

#### CANCELLATION CONDITIONS:
