\*\*Health and Fitness: To assist us when booking, please advise your Spark Travel consultant if you have any special needs such as mobility, dietary etc. A minimum level of fitness is required in order to be able to participate. You will need to able to walk up a flight of stairs and manage coach steps unaided and you must inform us before the commencement of the tour of any medical condition which may affect your ability to participate in the tour. If you are unable to manage on your own, it will be necessary to be accompanied by another person who is fit and able to assist you in day to day tasks and capable of providing the assistance required.

Dietary requests must be accompanied by the appropriate dietary information in writing.

#### HUGHES TRANSFERS TO AND FROM YOUR HOME:

Hughes transfers apply in the zoned area. These transfers may be available at additional cost to passengers who live outside the zoned area - please ask your Spark Travel consultant. 'HUGHES HOME PICK UP SERVICE' will call you two (2) days before the commencement of the tour to confirm the time they will be arriving at your home. If you have missed the call, please contact Spark Travel (08) 8876 5121 a day prior to departure for your pickup time. If you reside at a retirement village, please ensure Hughes have clear instructions from you as to means of entry and directions to find your home. Also, if you are out of zone there will be an additional payment due and this should be made at the time of booking. For safety reasons, suitcases should weigh no more than 20kgs. The Hughes home pick up service only applies to scheduled tour departure and return tour dates. Those passengers wishing to extend their tours will be responsible for their own transfers.

#### ITINERARY:

## DAY 01 - FRIDAY, 07 MARCH - ADELAIDE/BALLARAT - GUM SAN CHINESE HERITAGE CENTRE

Depart at **07.30am** from **Adelaide Central Bus Station**, 85 Franklin Street, Adelaide, on board our touring coach, travelling via the Heysen Tunnels and S.E. Freeway to Tailem Bend where we stop for a morning tea break (own cost). Continue via Keith and Bordertown, to the Grampians area and the historic gold mining town of **Ararat**. Here we will visit the world-class attraction of the **Gum San Chinese Heritage Centre** for an in-depth look at the Chinese mining heritage of the Central Goldfields. Designed in the traditional style of Southern Chinese architecture, the Gum San Chinese Heritage Centre incorporates the principles of Feng Shui and offers history, artifacts, culture and education.

From Ararat, we continue on to **Ballarat** via the beautiful tree-lined **Avenue of Honour** and the 17.5m **Arch of Victory**, to the well-known **Belltower Inn**, our home for the next four nights. **OVERNIGHT: BELLTOWER INN, BALLARAT. (D)** 

## DAY 02 - SATURDAY, 08 MARCH - FULL DAY TOUR TO THE OLD GOLD TOWNS OF VICTORIA

After breakfast, our local guide will join us for a tour to visit some of the smaller historic gold towns of Central Victoria. We begin with the township of Learmonth, then visit the magnificent old buildings of Clunes and Talbot. Later, explore the beautiful Maryborough Railway Station which impressed the author Mark Twain. Visit the lovely Castlemaine Botanic Gardens and take a fascinating drive around the town. At Daylesford we visit the Amazing Mill Markets with everything from vintage clothing, collectables, fine art to home décor and fine china. We return to Ballarat via the delightful little town of Creswick where there will be time to explore the retail shop at the Creswick Woollen Mills. Lunch will be supplied today. OVERNIGHT: BELLTOWER INN, BALLARAT. (B,L,D)

## DAY 03 - SUNDAY, 09 MARCH - IN BALLARAT - BALLARAT SIGHTS, DAY VISIT TO SOVEREIGN HILL. ART GALLERY OF BALLARAT

This morning we begin the day with a visit to **Sovereign Hill**, Australia's foremost outdoor museum, a re-creation of Ballarat's first 10 years after the discovery of gold. Explore the **Gold Museum** and view an impressive valuable collection of gold nuggets. See goldfields entertainers, steam-driven machinery in action and chat with wheelwrights, candlemakers and confectioners as they ply their trade. Later there will be a chance to explore the **Art Gallery of Ballarat**, established in 1884, not only Australia's oldest regional gallery, but one of its most exciting. Located in the heart of Ballarat's central heritage precinct, the Gallery boasts a stunning collection of Australian Art.

Dinner at the hotel this evening.

## DAY 04 - MONDAY, 10 MARCH - IN BALLARAT - BALLARAT BEGONIA FESTIVAL & BOTANICAL GARDENS, EVENING DINNER AND SPECTACULAR 'AURA' SOUND & LIGHT SHOW

This morning enjoy the colourful **Begonia Festival Parade**, after which there will be free time to explore the beautiful Botanical Gardens, view the wonderful multi-coloured display of tuberous Begonias in the **Robert Clark Conservatory** and maybe enjoy a stroll down the famous **Prime Ministers' Walk**. There is something for everyone at the Begonia Festival, from gardening tips and displays, craft and garden markets, food and beverage outlets, floral demonstrations and displays, music and entertainment.

#### EVENING SPECTACLE - 'AURA' SOUND & LIGHT SHOW AT SOVEREIGN HILL

Dinner this evening will be in the **New York Bakery at Sovereign Hill** after which we see history come alive. Be a part of 'Aura' and relive Australia's most important rebellion at Eureka in 1854 and as you travel under the night sky, learn the story of how gold revolutionised Australia. Over 64 acres of stunning projections create a storytelling experience which transports you back in time

#### DAY 05 - TUESDAY, 11 MARCH - BALLARAT/ADELAIDE

After breakfast we regretfully say farewell to our hospitable hosts at the Belltower Inn and board our coach for the return journey to **Adelaide via Nhill** and **Murray Bridge**, arriving back at **Adelaide Central Bus Station** at **7.00pm**. #### **FUEL SURCHARGES AND TAXES:**

#### SECURITY DEPOSIT:

A non-refundable security deposit of \$675.00 per person (inc GST) is required within five (5 days) of booking.

#### FINAL DAVMENTS

The security deposit forms part of the total price, the balance of which is due 30 days prior to departure, or in the case of bookings made within that 30 day period, the final payment is due as soon as the booking is confirmed.

#### LATE BOOKINGS AND AMENDMENTS:

Bookings made within 7 days inclusive of departure will incur a late booking fee of \$75.00 per person. Late bookings subject to availability. Once a booking has been made a \$75.00 per person amendment fee will apply for any alterations on selected departures only, and if applicable, one (1) change only to that booking. Transfers to other tours not permitted.

#### CREDIT CARDS:

If paying by credit card, a surcharge applies of 2% for Visa and Mastercard and 3.5% for Amex and Diners cards.

#### **CANCELLATION CONDITIONS:**
