'TORVILL & DEAN: OUR LAST DANCE' TOUR

After three decades, legends of the ice, Jayne Torvill & Christopher Dean, are set to make their long-awaited return to Australia. 'Torvill and Dean Our Last Dance' tour marks their first visit to Australian shores since their last tour in 1994 and will celebrate their illustrious career before retiring from skating together. In February 2024 Torvill & Dean, whilst in Sarajevo to commemorate their historic gold medal winning performance to Ravel's 'Bolero' at the 1984 Winter Olympics, relived the memories four decades on from their iconic heart-stopping Gold Medal win, in which they set a new standard for world-class figure skating.

MELBOURNE WINTER MASTERPIECES AT THE NGV - FRENCH IMPRESSIONISM

French Impressionism is a major exhibition from the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston, in conjunction with the NGV, and charts the trajectory of Impressionism in late 19th century France, highlighting the renowned avant-garde artists of the time. French Impressionism presents more than 100 paintings by key figures including Claude Monet, Pierre-August Renoir, Edgar Degas, Camille Pissarro, Edouard Manet, Mary Cassatt, Berthe Morisot, Paul Signac and Alfred Sisley. Experience the hallmarks of Impressionism, distinctive brushwork, vivid use of colour, innovative viewpoints and depictions of subjects and places dear to the artists.

NOTES:

Also, if you are out of zone there will be an additional payment due and this should be made at the time of booking. For safety reasons, suitcases should weigh no more than 20kgs. ITINERARY:

DAY 01 - TUESDAY, 17 JUNE - FLY ADELAIDE/MELBOURNE - MELBOURNE SIGHTS, HISTORIC ARCADES AND AFTERNOON TEA AT THE WINDSOR HOTEL

This morning meet with your Spark Travel Tour Manager at Adelaide Airport on Level 2 for your Virgin Australia flight to Melbourne. You will need to produce photo ID on check in and will be issued with your boarding pass.
