NOTES:

****Health and Fitness:** To assist us when booking, please advise your Spark Travel consultant if you have any special needs such as mobility, dietary etc. A minimum level of fitness is required in order to be able to participate. You will need to be able to walk up a flight of stairs and manage coach steps unaided and you must inform us before the commencement of the tour of any medical conditions which may affect your ability to participate in the tour. If you are unable to manage on your own, it will be necessary to be accompanied by another person who is fit and able to assist you in day to day tasks and capable of providing the assistance required.

Dietary requests must be accompanied by the appropriate dietary information in writing.

****It should be noted that to be fair to all passengers, specific coach seats cannot be reserved. We work a rotating seat system on board the coach.**

****Please note that on tours where flight/rail are involved, the seating within the confines of the group is computer allocated alphabetically by the airlines/rail company and beyond the control of Spark Travel.**

HUGHES TRANSFERS TO AND FROM YOUR HOME:

Hughes transfers apply in the zoned area. These transfers may be available at additional cost to passengers who live outside the zoned area - please ask your Spark Travel consultant.

'HUGHES HOME PICK UP SERVICE' will call you **two (2) days** before the commencement of the tour to confirm the time they will be arriving at your home. **If you have missed the call, please contact Spark Travel (08) 8876 5121 a day prior to departure** for your pickup time. **If you reside at a retirement village, please ensure Hughes have clear instructions from you as to means of entry and directions to find your home. Also, if you are out of zone there will be an additional payment due and this should be made at the time of booking.** For safety reasons, suitcases should weigh no more than 20kgs. The Hughes home pick up service only applies to scheduled tour departure and return tour dates. Those passengers wishing to extend their tours will be responsible for their own transfers.

ITINERARY:

DAY 01 - THURSDAY, 23 OCTOBER - FLY ADELAIDE/SYDNEY - SIGHTS TOUR - THE TEA ROOM AT QVB

On arrival at **Adelaide Airport**, your **Spark Travel Tour Manager** will be waiting upstairs in the terminal to greet and assist you with check in. Please have photo ID ready for inspection to pick up your boarding pass.

06.00am Depart Adelaide on Virgin Australia flight VA401, arriving Sydney Airport at 8.20am.

We join our coach for an interesting familiarisation **sights tour** of Sydney. See Hyde Park, St Mary's Cathedral, Sydney Opera House and spectacular views of Sydney and the Harbour from Mrs Macquarie's Chair. Late morning we head off to the **Tea Room** in the historic **Queen Victoria Building** for delightful **Light Tea** refreshments of petit cakes, savoury pastries, finger sandwiches, tea and coffee.

To end the day, visit the **Art Gallery of NSW** for an opportunity to view the exciting **2025 Archibald Exhibition**.

Later check in at the **Vibe Sydney Hotel**, our home for the next 3 nights.

DAY 02 - FRIDAY, 24 OCTOBER - IN SYDNEY - DARLING HARBOUR, CAPTAIN COOK PREMIUM HARBOUR EXPERIENCE CRUISE - EVENING - 'THE BOOK OF MORMON' AT THE CAPITOL THEATRE

This morning, enjoy free time for own exploration around the delights of Darling Harbour. This afternoon we take the **Captain Cook Premium Harbour Experience cruise** from Darling Harbour King Street Wharf No.1 for a **90 minute full circuit of Sydney Harbour**, one of the world's most beautiful and natural harbours. As you cruise, enjoy **one house beverage of your choice**, plus an **Australian Cheese & Charcuterie Board to share**. See the magnificent Opera House from a different perspective, Fort Denison, Sydney Harbour Bridge and the impressive Sydney skyline.

'THE BOOK OF MORMON' AT THE CAPITOL THEATRE

This evening transfer to the Capitol Theatre, where from our 'A' Reserve seats in the stalls, enjoy the **7.30pm** performance of **'THE BOOK OF MORMON'** musical.

After the show we conclude the evening at our hotel with a **light supper**.

DAY 03 - SATURDAY, 25 OCTOBER - FULL DAY BLUE MOUNTAINS - HISTORIC ZIG ZAG RAILWAY, GOVETTS LEAP LOOK OUT, KATOOMBA AND ECHO POINT

This morning after breakfast, we make our way via the Great Western Highway to the magnificent **Blue Mountains**. After a stop to admire the spectacular scenery at **Govetts Leap Lookout** near Blackheath, we then head to the small town of **Clarence**, where originally was a railway outpost on the Main Western railway line, across the Blue Mountains. After a **light lunch** in the Café at Clarence Station, we board the **Zig Zag Railway** for a 90 minute ride from **Clarence to Bottom Points**, and enjoy spectacular scenery on this historic railway.

Later, explore **Echo Point** and see the spectacular **Three Sisters**, a giant rock formation of an Aboriginal legend. Take the scenic cliff drive, viewing the Jamison Valley, often referred to as Australia's Grand Canyon with its sheer sandstone cliffs of pink and rust colours, after which we make our way back to our accommodation in Sydney.

DAY 04 - SUNDAY, 26 OCTOBER - SYDNEY/ADELAIDE - THE ROCKS SUNDAY MARKETS, LA PEROUSE, LUNCH AT BRIGHTON LE SANDS RSL

This morning, we load our bags and first head off for some free time to explore the delights of **The Rocks Sunday Markets**. Don't forget to walk along Playfair Street to view the sculpture of **'Biggles'**, the famous Schnauzer who was a much-loved former member of the community. Next, a short stop at historic **La Perouse** on the northern headland of Botany Bay, then onto **Brighton Le Sands** on the shores of **Botany Bay**. Lady Robinson's Beach, at 7kms in length, is the longest beach in Sydney, named after Governor Sir Hercules Robinson's wife in 1874. Enjoy a delightful **lunch at the Brighton Le Sands RSL**, after which there will be free time to explore. Perhaps take a stroll along the Grand Parade overlooking the bay, view the Bicentennial Monument which commemorates the First Fleet Landing in 1788, the statue of 1896 Olympian Spyros Louis, or maybe stay at the RSL for a drink, the choice is yours. Later, transfer to Sydney Airport for the flight home.

Please ensure you have **photo ID** ready for presentation in order to receive your boarding pass. **7.30pm** Depart **Sydney Airport** on Virgin Australia flight **VA442**, arriving **Adelaide Airport** at **9.10pm**. **(B,L)**

TRAVEL INSURANCE:

Should you have any pre-existing medical conditions, please let your consultant know so they can be listed on the policy.

EVENTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF SPARK TRAVEL:

Should an event occur which is beyond the control of Spark Travel, ie: delays to ship, aircraft, train, coach thereby incurring extra expenses, these additional costs are borne by the passenger at the time of the event. A travel insurance claim for reimbursement should be submitted to the insurance company upon return home. Please keep any receipts. It should be understood that neither Spark Travel nor any subsidiary company or representative shall be liable for any loss, injury or damage arising from our services.

ITINERARIES:

Itineraries are subject to change and no responsibility can be accepted. Coach operator and size of coach may be changed at the discretion of Spark Travel without notice. Where a tour does not meet minimum numbers travelling together on the outward journey a cost surcharge will apply. If group numbers fall below 15 adult paying passengers no tour leader will be provided. No itemisation of tour arrangements can be given and no refund for any portion of a tour not taken. Flora and fauna as described in an itinerary is nature and as such cannot be guaranteed.

ACCOMMODATION:

Spark Travel reserves the right to alter hotel/motel accommodation and to substitute a suitable alternative. Where accommodation is booked on a 'will share basis,' at the time of finalisation if there is nobody suitable to share with, it may be necessary to pay the appropriate single supplement. Spark Travel does not accept any responsibility for the non-compatibility of 'sharing' clients. If by choice a single room is requested and booked a single room surcharge will apply.

HEALTH AND FITNESS:

A minimum level of fitness is required in order to be able to participate. As a minimum you will need to be able to walk up a flight of stairs and manage coach steps unaided. You must inform us before the commencement of the tour of any medical condition which may affect your ability to participate in the tour. Dietary requests must be accompanied by the appropriate dietary information. It is recommended masks be worn on flights and in crowded or inside spaces. To protect yourself and fellow travellers, vaccination against Covid-19 is recommended.

FUEL SURCHARGES AND TAXES:

All bookings may attract additional fuel surcharges and taxes which can be levied up to and including the date of departure even if final payment has been made. Booking is subject to final audit.

SECURITY DEPOSIT:

A non-refundable security deposit of **\$675.00 per person (inc GST)** is required within five (5 days) of booking.

FINAL PAYMENTS:

The security deposit forms part of the total price, the balance of which is due 60 days prior to departure, or in the case of bookings made within that 60 day period, the final payment is due as soon as the booking is confirmed.

LATE BOOKINGS AND AMENDMENTS:

Bookings made within 7 days inclusive of departure will incur a **late booking fee of \$75.00 per person**. Late bookings subject to availability. Once a booking has been made a **\$75.00 per person amendment fee** will apply for any alterations on selected departures only, and if applicable, one (1) change only to that booking. Transfers to other tours not permitted.

CREDIT CARDS:

If paying by credit card, a surcharge applies of 2% for Visa and Mastercard and 3.5% for Amex and Diners cards.

CANCELLATION CONDITIONS:

- i) We act as an Agent; and
- ii) That our Terms and Conditions are in addition to the Terms and Conditions of each Travel supplier listed on the quote itinerary; and
- iii) That it is the Terms and Conditions of the Travel supplier that determine the terms of cancellation and refunds, if any.

BOOKINGS CANCELLED AFTER THE FINAL PAYMENT HAS BEEN MADE:

- (a) Bookings cancelled 61 days or earlier, full refund less deposit and booking fee and any other non-refundable services or products.
- (b) Bookings cancelled 60 days or less prior to departure will incur a cancellation fee of 100% of the tour cost.
- (c) No refund can be given for any portion of the tour not taken and no refund after the tour has commenced.
