MELBOURNE WINTER MASTERPIECES AT THE NGV - FRENCH IMPRESSIONISM

French Impressionism is a major exhibition from the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston, in conjunction with the NGV. It charts the trajectory of Impressionism in late 19th century France, highlighting the renowned avant-garde artists of the time.

French Impressionism presents more than 100 paintings by key figures including Claude Monet, Pierre-August Renoir, Edgar Degas, Camille Pissarro, Edouard Manet, Mary Cassatt, Berthe Morisot, Paul Signac and Alfred Sisley. Experience the hallmarks of Impressionism, distinctive brushwork, vivid use of colour, innovative viewpoints, depictions of subjects and places dear to the artists.

HUGHES TRANSFERS TO AND FROM YOUR HOME:

Hughes transfers apply in the zoned area. These transfers may be available at additional cost to passengers who live outside the zoned area - please ask your Spark Travel consultant. 'HUGHES HOME PICK UP SERVICE' will call you two (2) days before the commencement of the tour to confirm the time they will be arriving at your home. If you have missed the call, please contact Spark Travel (08) 8876 5121 a day prior to departure for your pickup time. If you reside at a retirement village, please ensure Hughes have clear instructions from you as to means of entry and directions to find your home. Also, if you are out of zone there will be an additional payment due and this should be made at the time of booking. For safety reasons, suitcases should weigh no more than 20kgs. The Hughes home pick up service only applies to scheduled tour departure and return tour dates. Those passengers wishing to extend their tours will be responsible for their own transfers.

We travel to **Melbourne and return** on **The Overland** in comfortable **Red Service Premium seats**. You will be seated in either a 2 or 1 seat configuration with only a maximum of 36 seats in the carriage. **Your fare includes complimentary breakfast, lunch and afternoon tea.**

ITINERARY:

DAY 01 - THURSDAY - THE OVERLAND - ADELAIDE/MELBOURNE

This morning arrive at Adelaide Parklands Terminal (formerly Keswick Station). MEET THE SPARK TRAVEL REPRESENTATIVE IN THE DEPARTURE LOUNGE.

Your Tour Manager will assist with check in and accompany you to The Overland which departs Adelaide at 06.55am. Newly refurbished, The Overland is about letting you enjoy the journey. Sit back and relax in a comfortable Red Service Premium seat with ample leg room and watch the ever changing scenery pass by as we travel from South Australia and into Victoria. A complimentary breakfast, lunch and afternoon tea will be served to your seat today.

We arrive at **Melbourne Southern Cross Station at 6.50pm**, then head off to our hotel for the next 4 nights.

DAY 02 - FRIDAY - IN MELBOURNE - WERRIBEE OPEN RANGE ZOO, VICTORIA STATE ROSE GARDEN, DELIGHTFUL HIGH TEA AT 'GARDEN FEAST'

After breakfast, we head off to **Werribee Open Range Zoo**. Here enjoy a **morning safari ride**, viewing rhinos, giraffes, zebras, antelopes and more. Maybe purchase lunch in the Meerkat Cafe as you watch the entertaining Meerkats play. There is also an excellent shop with gifts to take home.

Later, we depart for **Werribee Park** where there will be time to stroll the lovely **Victoria State Rose Garden**. With over 5,000 roses, it was awarded the International Garden of Excellence in 2003 by the World Federation of Rose Societies.

To end the day, we then head off to the nearby 'Garden Feast' for a delightful High Tea and glass of 'bubbly,' and an opportunity to browse the beautiful plant nursery and gift shop. Dinner supplied tonight.

DAY 03 - SATURDAY - IN MELBOURNE - DANDENONGS - 'PUFFING BILLY,' TESSELAAR TULIP FESTIVAL. CLOUDEHILL GARDEN

Today, enjoy some marvellous sights. We begin the day at **Belgrave** with a ride on board the famous **'Puffing Billy'** Steam train to **Emerald Lakeside** through the magnificent giant trees of the Dandenongs, then our journey then takes us on to the famous **Tesselaar Tulip Festival** at Silvan. We can stroll at leisure amongst the acres of blazing colour amongst the tulips, daffodils, freesias, hyacinths and iris and enjoy a ride around the property on board the **Tractor Train**. This is a **'little piece of Holland'** in the hills, with traditional dress, windmills, wishing well, and Dutch music. Refreshments are available for purchase. Last stop for the day will be a visit to **Jeremy Francis' Cloudehill Garden**. Enjoy the magnificent formal gardens divided into 20 different components surrounded by a glorious backdrop of mature Beech, Maple, Rhododendron and Magnolia and an opportunity to explore the Diggers garden shop. Enjoy a 'cuppa' in **Seasons at Cloudehill**, after which we rejoin our coach for the journey back to our hotel in Melbourne. **Dinner** at the hotel tonight.

DAY 04 - SUNDAY - IN MELBOURNE - NGV & WINTER MASTERPIECES, SIGHTS, FREE TIME

This morning, after breakfast at the hotel, we transfer to the **National Gallery of Victoria** for the fabulous **Winter Masterpieces – 'French Impressionism.'** There will also be time to explore other exhibitions at the NGV.

Later, enjoy a sights tour of **Melbourne** including a visit to the beautiful **Fitzroy Gardens** with superb avenues of huge English elms planted along gently contoured lawns including one of Melbourne's favourite attractions, the **Conservatory**, with its spectacular floral displays. Also visit the **Shrine of Remembrance** and there will also be time allowed in the City for some **'retail therapy.'**

Dinner at the hotel tonight.

Itineraries are subject to change and no responsibility can be accepted. Coach operator and size of coach may be changed at the discretion of Spark Travel without notice. Where a tour does not meet minimum numbers travelling together on the outward journey a cost surcharge will apply. If group numbers fall below 15 adult paying passengers no tour leader will be provided. No itemisation of tour arrangements can be given and no refund for any portion of a tour not taken. ACCOMMODATION:

Spark Travel does not accept any responsibility for the non-compatibility of 'sharing' clients. If by choice a single room is requested and booked a single room surcharge will apply.

You must inform us before the commencement of the tour of any medical condition which may affect your ability to participate in the tour. Dietarty requests must be accompanied by the appropriate dietary information. It is recommended masks be worn on flights and in crowded or inside spaces. FUEL SURCHARGES AND TAXES:

All bookings may attract additional fuel surcharges and taxes which can be levied up to and including the date of departure even if final payment has been made. Booking is subject to final audit.

SECURITY DEPOSIT:

A non-refundable security deposit of \$675.00 per person (inc GST) is required within five (5 days) of booking.

FINAL PAYMENTS

The security deposit forms part of the total price, the balance of which is due 60 days prior to departure, or in the case of bookings made within that 60 day period, the final payment is due as soon as the booking is confirmed.

LATE BOOKINGS AND AMENDMENTS:

Bookings made within 7 days inclusive of departure will incur a late booking fee of \$75.00 per person. Late bookings subject to availability. Once a booking has been made a \$75.00 per person amendment fee will apply for any alterations on selected departures only, and if applicable, one (1) change only to that booking. Transfers to other tours not permitted.

CREDIT CARDS:

If paying by credit card, a surcharge applies of 2% for Visa and Mastercard and 3.5% for Amex and Diners cards.

CANCELLATION CONDITIONS:
