NOTES:

HUGHES TRANSFERS TO AND FROM YOUR HOME:

Hughes transfers apply in the zoned area. These transfers may be available at additional cost to passengers who live outside the zoned area - please ask your Spark Travel consultant. 'HUGHES HOME PICK UP SERVICE' will call you two (2) days before the commencement of the tour to confirm the time they will be arriving at your home. If you have missed the call, please contact Spark Travel (08) 8876 5121 a day prior to departure for your pickup time. If you reside at a retirement village, please ensure Hughes have clear instructions from you as to means of entry and directions to find your home. Also, if you are out of zone there will be an additional payment due and this should be made at the time of booking. For safety reasons, suitcases should weigh no more than 20kgs. The Hughes home pick up service only applies to scheduled tour departure and return tour dates. Those passengers wishing to extend their tours will be responsible for their own transfers.

ITINERARY:

DAY 01 - THURSDAY, 02 OCTOBER - THE OVERLAND ADELAIDE/MELBOURNE

This morning arrive at Adelaide Parklands Terminal.

MEET THE SPARK TRAVEL REPRESENTATIVE IN THE DEPARTURE LOUNGE.

The representative will assist with check in and board The Overland which departs Adelaide at 06.55am. Newly refurbished, The Overland is about letting you enjoy the journey. Sit back and relax in a comfortable Red Service Premium seat with ample leg room and watch the ever changing scenery pass by travelling from South Australia into Victoria. A complimentary breakfast, lunch and afternoon tea will be served to your seat today.

We arrive at Melbourne Southern Cross Station at 6.50pm, then transfer to our hotel for the next 3 nights. (Note: A suitcase with wheels is essential as everyone is responsible for their own baggage.) Dinner will be provided tonight.

DAY 02 - FRIDAY, 03 OCTOBER - IN MELBOURNE - FULL DAY TOUR TO THE MORNINGTON PENINSULA - EXPLORE MORNINGTON, WINE TASTING AND LUNCH AT RED HILL ESTATE, ASHCOMBE MAZE & LAVENDER GARDENS. TYABB PACKING HOUSE

This morning we head off to the beautiful **Mornington Peninsula** and the seaside town of **Mornington**, with its beautiful beaches and a town centre which runs right into the foreshore area and local beach. You will have **free time** to explore, relax and enjoy a coffee or maybe do a bit of 'retail therapy' at the many eclectic shops in the town. Our route then takes us on to **Main Ridge** and the family-owned **Red Hill Estate** where we will enjoy a **tasting of their quality cold-climate** wines, followed by a **share platter light lunch**.

Next stop will be at the **Ashcombe Maze** and **Lavender Gardens**. The world acclaimed gardens features the magnificent **Rose Maze**, famous for its 1000 different roses along with a range of lavender types on display that flower 12 months of the year. From the Maze, we then head off for our last stop of the day at the **Tyabb Packing House** – one of the largest centres of antiques, vintage, retro and collectibles in the Southern Hemisphere, after which we return to our accommodation in Melbourne.

This morning after breakfast at the hotel we transfer to the National Gallery of Victoria for the fabulous annual Winter Masterpieces 2025 – French Impressionism. Time will be allowed to view this stunning exhibition as well as time to explore other exhibitions at the NGV. Lunch can be purchased at the Gallery café. Later, enjoy a familiarisation sights tour of Melbourne. Stroll the lovely Fitzroy Gardens and Conservatory and spend some quality time at the moving Shrine of Remembrance.

This evening, transfer to Her Majesty's Theatre, where from our seats in the stalls, enjoy the **7.30pm** performance of 'MJ THE MUSICAL.'

After breakfast we check out and load our bags onto the coach and head off to Harbour Esplanade Docklands to join the **Melbourne Tramboat** cruise down to the old maritime seaport of Williamstown. It should be understood that neither Spark Travel nor any subsidiary company or representative shall be liable for any loss, injury or damage arising from our services.

ITINERARIES:

Itineraries are subject to change and no responsibility can be accepted. Coach operator and size of coach may be changed at the discretion of Spark Travel without notice. Where a tour does not meet minimum numbers travelling together on the outward journey a cost surcharge will apply. If group numbers fall below 15 adult paying passengers no tour leader will be provided. No itemisation of tour arrangements can be given and no refund for any portion of a tour not taken. ACCOMMODATION:

Spark Travel reserves the right to alter hotel/motel accommodation and to substitute a suitable alternative. Where accommodation is booked on a 'will share basis,' at the time of finalisation if there is nobody suitable to share with, it may be necessary to pay the appropriate single supplement. Spark Travel does not accept any responsibility for the non-compatibility of 'sharing' clients. If by choice a single room is requested and booked a single room surcharge will apply.

HEALTH AND FITNESS:

A minimum level of fitness is required in order to be able to participate. As a minimum you will need to able to walk up a flight of stairs and manage coach steps unaided. You must inform us before the commencement of the tour of any medical condition which may affect your ability to participate in the tour. Dietarty requests must be accompanied by the appropriate dietary information. It is recommended masks be worn on flights and in crowded or inside spaces. To protect yourself and fellow travellers, vaccination against Covid-19 is recommended.

FUEL SURCHARGES AND TAXES:

All bookings may attract additional fuel surcharges and taxes which can be levied up to and including the date of departure even if final payment has been made. Booking is subject to final audit.

SECURITY DEPOSIT:

A non-refundable security deposit of \$675.00 per person (inc GST) is required within five (5 days) of booking.

FINAL PAYMENTS:

The security deposit forms part of the total price, the balance of which is due 60 days prior to departure, or in the case of bookings made within that 60 day period, the final payment is due as soon as the booking is confirmed.

LATE BOOKINGS AND AMENDMENTS:

Bookings made within 7 days inclusive of departure will incur a late booking fee of \$75.00 per person. Late bookings subject to availability. Once a booking has been made a \$75.00 per person amendment fee will apply for any alterations on selected departures only, and if applicable, one (1) change only to that booking. Transfers to other tours not permitted.

CREDIT CARDS:

If paying by credit card, a surcharge applies of 2% for Visa and Mastercard.

CANCELLATION CONDITIONS:

i) We act as an Agent; and

- ii) That our Terms and Conditions are in addition to the Terms and Conditions of each Travel supplier listed on the quote itinerary; and iii) That it is the Terms and Conditions of the Travel supplier that determine the terms of cancellation and refunds, if any.
