\*\*It should be noted that to be fair to all passengers, specific coach seats cannot be reserved. we work a rotating seat system on board the coach.

#### HUGHES TRANSFERS TO AND FROM YOUR HOME:

Hughes transfers apply in the zoned area. These transfers may be available at additional cost to passengers who live outside the zoned area - please ask your Spark Travel consultant. 'HUGHES HOME PICK UP SERVICE' will call you two (2) days before the commencement of the tour to confirm the time they will be arriving at your home. If you have missed the call, please contact Spark Travel (08) 8876 5121 a day prior to departure for your pickup time. If you reside at a retirement village, please ensure Hughes have clear instructions from you as to means of entry and directions to find your home. If you are out of zone there will be an additional payment due and this should be made at the time of booking. For safety reasons, suitcases should weigh no more than 20kgs. The Hughes home pick up service only applies to scheduled tour departure and return tour dates. Those passengers wishing to extend their tours will be responsible for their own transfers.

# DAY 01 - TUESDAY, 10 FEBRUARY - FLY ADELAIDE/BRISBANE, MT COOT-THA BOTANIC GARDENS

Meet your Spark Travel Tour Manager upstairs on Level 2 at Adelaide Airport and please have photo ID ready to receive your boarding pass.

Depart Adelaide Airport at 6.10am on board Virgin Australia flight VA1385, arriving in Brisbane Airport at 8.10am. Enjoy a light lunch in the Botanic Gardens Café. Later, we head back to the city and check in at the Stamford Plaza Brisbane, our home for the next 3 nights.

This afternoon we take a delightful afternoon tea cruise on the Brisbane River with Brisbane River City Cruises on board the MV Neptune. Experience the unique charm of Brisbane's river scene as you enjoy a 1.5 hour cruise. See the Kangaroo Point cliffs, City Centre, Story Bridge, New Farm Park, the Powerhouse and Brisbane's riverside homes. This is why Brisbane is called the 'River City.' After our cruise, transfer back to the hotel.

After breakfast, we check out from our hotel and enjoy some free time to explore the Brisbane city area. Later, rejoin our coach and transfer down to Howard Smith Wharves, where, under the Story Bridge at the Felons Brewing Co, we will enjoy a share platter lunch (drinks at own cost). Later, we head for the Brisbane suburb of Redcliffe to visit Bee Gees Way – a 70m walkway which honours Redcliffe's most famous young residents who went on to be one of the top-selling bands of all time. The walkway was opened in 2 stages in 2013 and 2015 by Barry Gibb and presents as a multi-media mini outdoor museum.

A refreshment stop will be made (own cost), before we arrive at Brisbane Airport for our flight home.

#### SECURITY DEPOSIT:

A non-refundable security deposit of \$875.00 per person (inc GST) is required within five (5 days) of booking.

#### FINAL PAYMENTS:
