****Flight seating:** Please note that on tours where flights are involved, the seating within the confines of the group is computer allocated alphabetically by the airlines and beyond the control of Spark Travel.

****Tour extensions** subject to availability and extension booking criteria.

CHAUFFEURED TRANSFERS TO AND FROM YOUR HOME:

Chauffeured transfers apply in the zoned area. These transfers may be available at additional cost to passengers who live outside the zoned area - please ask your Spark Travel consultant. 'HOME PICK UP SERVICE' will call you **two (2) days** before the commencement of the tour to confirm the time they will be arriving at your home. **If you have missed the call, please contact Spark Travel (08) 8876 5121 a day prior to departure** for your pickup time. **If you reside at a retirement village, please ensure Spark Travel have clear instructions from you as to means of entry and directions to find your home. If you are out of zone there will be an additional payment due, this should be made at the time of booking.** For safety reasons, suitcases should weigh no more than 20kgs. The Adelaide home pick up service only applies to scheduled tour departure and return tour dates. Those passengers wishing to extend their tours will be responsible for their own transfers.

ITINERARY:

DAY 01 - THURSDAY, 22 OCTOBER: FLY ADELAIDE/SYDNEY - SIGHTS TOUR

On arrival at **Adelaide Airport** your **Spark Travel Tour Manager** will be waiting upstairs in the terminal on Level 2 to greet and assist you with check in. Please have valid photo ID ready for inspection to pick up your boarding pass.

9.30am Depart **Adelaide** on **Virgin Australia flight VA413**, arriving **Sydney Airport** at **11.50am**.

We join our coach and head off to the new **Sydney Fish Market** with its many bars and cafes for **own lunch arrangements**, and in the afternoon we undertake an interesting familiarisation **sights tour** of Sydney. See Hyde Park, St Mary's Cathedral, Sydney Opera House and spectacular views of Sydney and the Harbour from Mrs Macquarie's Chair. Later check in at the Vibe Sydney Hotel, for the next 3 nights.

Dinner in the hotel.

DAY 02 - FRIDAY, 23 OCTOBER: IN SYDNEY - THE RIVERBOAT POSTMAN, EVENING - 'MY FAIR LADY' AT THE SYDNEY OPERA HOUSE

This morning after breakfast we head off an hour north of Sydney to **Brooklyn** on the mighty **Hawkesbury River** where we board **The Riverboat Postman**. **Morning tea** is served on arrival with percolated coffee, hot tea and delicious home-made ANZAC biscuits. Enjoy the magnificent scenery of the lower Hawkesbury River as the boat delivers the mail and other essentials to the upriver settlements only accessible by river (weekdays) or around the incredible National Parks surrounding the Hawkesbury River and Cowan Creek (weekends). Be entertained by stories of the river whilst cruising in comfort up this spectacular waterway, and before disembarking enjoy a delightful **Aussie Plowmans lunch**. The boat is fully licensed for those who would like to purchase a glass of wine, beer, or soft drink with lunch.

At the conclusion of our cruise, we rejoin our coach and head off back to Sydney for a bit of 'downtime,' before our evening at the theatre.

'MY FAIR LADY' AT THE SYDNEY OPERA HOUSE'

This evening transfer to the **Joan Sutherland Theatre** in the **Sydney Opera House**, where from our excellent seats in the Stalls, enjoy the **7.30pm performance of 'My Fair Lady.'** After the show we conclude the evening at our hotel with a **light supper and glass of 'bubbly'.**

DAY 03 - SATURDAY, 24 OCTOBER: IN SYDNEY - BLUE MOUNTAINS & THE HARTLEY VALLEY GARDEN FESTIVAL

This morning we head off to the **Blue Mountains**, first making a short stop to admire the view and the iconic rock formation, **The Three Sisters**. From here we head to the **Hartley Valley Garden Festival** with visits to magnificent private gardens in **Little Hartley**. Take in the spectacular mountain views and fresh country air as you peruse the plant and Artisan stalls - food, metal garden art, artisan stalls, oil paintings and rare plants. Visit **Hartvale Gardens**, nestled on 5 gently undulating acres at the base of Mt York with stunning valley and escarpment views to Mt Clarence. Then on to **Goryu** an authentic Japanese Garden, featuring Zen gardens, Torii gate, shrines and a full moon bridge. Enjoy a **picnic lunch** today.

Later we depart Little Hartley with a stop at famous **Govett's Leap Lookout**, then back through Katoomba to the lovely township of **Leura** and end our day in the Blue Mountains with a fabulous **High Tea at Bygone Beautys Teapot Museum and Tearooms** - home of the world's largest private collection of teapots - over 11,000 in fact.

Own dinner arrangements this evening.

DAY 04 - SUNDAY, 25 OCTOBER: SYDNEY/ADELAIDE - THE ROCKS WEEKEND MARKETS, LA PEROUSE, LUNCH AT BRIGHTON LE SANDS RSL

This morning, we load the bags and head off for some free time to explore the delights of **The Rocks Weekend Markets** - and don't forget to walk along Playfair Street to view the sculpture of 'Biggles,' the famous Schnauzer who was a much-loved former member of the community.

Next, a short stop at the historic **La Perouse** on the northern headland of Botany Bay, then on to **Brighton Le Sands** on the shores of **Botany Bay**. Lady Robinson's Beach, at 7kms in length, is the longest beach in Sydney, in 1874 named after Governor Sir Hercules Robinson's wife.

Also along the Grand Parade overlooking the bay, view the **Bicentennial Monument** which commemorates the First Fleet Landing in 1788 and the statue of **1896 Olympian Spyros Louis**. Enjoy a delightful **lunch at the Brighton Le Sands RSL**, after which we transfer to **Sydney Airport** for the flight home.

Please ensure you have valid **photo ID** ready for presentation in order to receive your boarding pass.

5.30pm Depart **Sydney Airport** on **Virgin Australia** flight **VA434**, arriving **Adelaide Airport** at **7.10pm**. **(B,L)**

TRAVEL INSURANCE:

Should you have any pre-existing medical conditions, please let your consultant know so they can be listed on the policy.

EVENTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF SPARK TRAVEL:

Should an event occur which is beyond the control of Spark Travel, ie: delays to ship, aircraft, train, coach thereby incurring extra expenses, these additional costs are borne by the passenger at the time of the event. A travel insurance claim for reimbursement should be submitted to the insurance company upon return home. Please keep any receipts. It should be understood that neither Spark Travel nor any subsidiary company or representative shall be liable for any loss, injury or damage arising from our services.

ITINERARIES:

Itineraries are subject to change and no responsibility can be accepted. Coach operator and size of coach may be changed at the discretion of Spark Travel without notice. Where a tour does not meet minimum numbers travelling together on the outward journey a cost surcharge will apply. If group numbers fall below 15 adult paying passengers no tour leader will be provided. No itemisation of tour arrangements can be given and no refund for any portion of a tour not taken. Flora and fauna as described in an itinerary is nature and as such cannot be guaranteed.

ACCOMMODATION:

Spark Travel reserves the right to alter hotel/motel accommodation and to substitute a suitable alternative.

HEALTH AND FITNESS:

A minimum level of fitness is required in order to be able to participate. As a minimum you will need to be able to walk up a flight of stairs and manage coach steps unaided. You must inform us before the commencement of the tour of any medical condition which may affect your ability to participate in the tour. Dietary requests must be accompanied by the appropriate dietary information. It is recommended masks be worn on flights and in crowded or inside spaces. To protect yourself and fellow travellers, vaccination against Covid-19 is recommended.

FUEL SURCHARGES AND TAXES:

All bookings may attract additional fuel surcharges and taxes which can be levied up to and including the date of departure even if final payment has been made. Booking is subject to final audit.

SECURITY DEPOSIT:

A non-refundable security deposit of **\$675.00 per person (inc GST)** is required within five (5 days) of booking.

FINAL PAYMENTS:

The security deposit forms part of the total price, the balance of which is due 60 days prior to departure, or in the case of bookings made within that 60 day period, the final payment is due as soon as the booking is confirmed.

LATE BOOKINGS AND AMENDMENTS:

Bookings made within 7 days inclusive of departure will incur a **late booking fee of \$75.00 per person**. Late bookings subject to availability. Once a booking has been made a **\$75.00 per person amendment fee** will apply for any alterations on selected departures only, and if applicable, one (1) change only to that booking. Transfers to other tours not permitted.

CREDIT CARDS:

If paying by credit card, a surcharge applies of 2% for Visa and Mastercard.

CANCELLATION CONDITIONS:

- i) We act as an Agent; and
- ii) That our Terms and Conditions are in addition to the Terms and Conditions of each Travel supplier listed on the quote itinerary; and
- iii) That it is the Terms and Conditions of the Travel supplier that determine the terms of cancellation and refunds, if any.

BOOKINGS CANCELLED AFTER THE FINAL PAYMENT HAS BEEN MADE:

- (a) Bookings cancelled 61 days or earlier, full refund less deposit and booking fee and any other non-refundable services or products.
- (b) Bookings cancelled 60 days or less prior to departure will incur a cancellation fee of 100% of the tour cost.
- (c) No refund can be given for any portion of the tour not taken and no refund after the tour has commenced.
